My Vision to Support ANS: 2012-2014

Initiative One: *Strategic Plan Implementation/Integration*

- Manage Strategic Plan implementation/integration

Working with Membership Committee and new Membership & Marketing Director to roll out new membership development plan in 2013



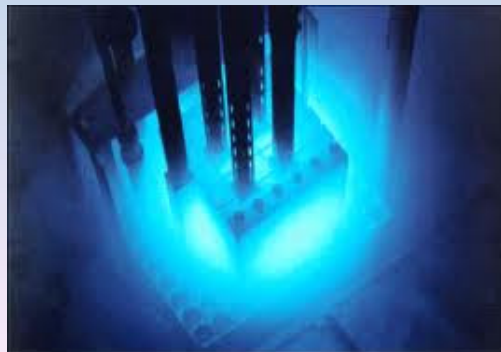

Entities*



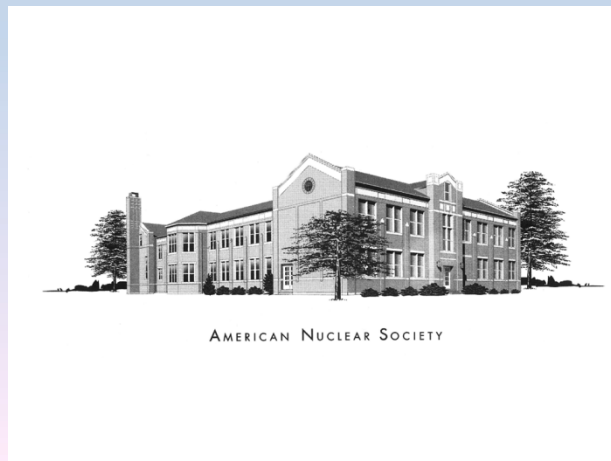
Status:

- 2) Building relations with other organizations that have policy issues of mutual concern



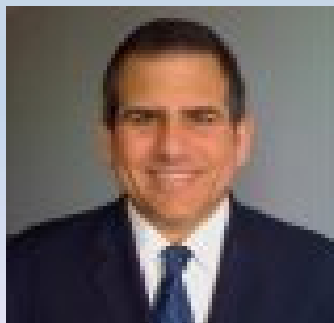

Status:

- 1) Identifying possible new products, programs and services for increasing revenue
 - a) Offering Web-based learning programs
 - b) Providing support services for other societies
 - c) Selling newly digitized archived journals
 - d) Offering digitization services
 - e) Creating Professional Division posters/technical aids
 - f) Selling ANS paper review software
 - g) Expanding corporate sponsorship and advertising opportunities
- 2) Assessing current products, programs and services to determine their value and financial sustainability
- 3) Finding ways to become more efficient and reduce overhead
- 4) Evaluating revenue and expenditures versus the level of member satisfaction



My Vision to Support ANS: 2012-2014

Initiative Eight: *Expand Member Participation*

- Create clear path for all members to participate in leadership and governance

Status:

Initiative Nine: *Enhance International Relevance,
Influence and Perception*

Support ANS growth globally



Status:

- 1) Visited several countries since July 1, 2012 and spoke to nuclear industry and government leaders and leaders of nuclear societies to set up collaborative relationships
 - Mexico, UK, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Turkey, Thailand, Malaysia, Vietnam, India, South Korea, China, Austria and France



Status:

2) Met with and presented to following International ANS Local Sections:

- Latin American Local Section
- Austria Local Section
- French Local Section
- India Local Section

3) Met with Presidents and Executive Directors of National Academy of Science and National Academy of Engineering to establish more collaborative relationships and coordination of activities
