### "Recent Advances at LANL in Production of $^{99}\text{Mo}$ "

Speaker: Steven Klein, Los Alamos National Laboratory, R&D Scientist

**Abstract:** Since 2009 Los Alamos National Laboratory has provided technical support to private industry in developing three different technologies intended to produce the important medical isotope Molybdenum-99 ( $^{99}\text{Mo}$ ). This work is supported by direct funding from NNSA (NA-21) and through the private entities under Cooperative Agreements. Two technologies employ fissile solutions of Low Enriched Uranium (LEU), one in the form of an aqueous homogeneous reactor (AHR), the other an accelerator-driven subcritical configuration. The third technology also utilizes an accelerator but not a uranium target. Research and development reported includes the review of the historical record of 65 years of operation of AHR at LANL; particularly the startling lack of empirical data directly applicable to the proposed systems and advances in our understanding of these processes over the last two years by theoretical treatment and directed experiments. The current state of progress toward realization of a domestic  $^{99}\text{Mo}$  production capability and near-term plans are also discussed.

**Biography:** Steve Klein is the technical lead for the AHR  $^{99}\text{Mo}$  Project at LANL. He has over 35 years of systems engineering experience in a wide variety of military and commercial development programs, including those for proton cancer therapy and the critical assembly machines upgrade and relocation to NTS. He holds an advanced degree in Physics, is licensed as a Professional Engineer in the State of Texas, and is an Airline Transport Pilot.
